## Excursion fee information for exchange students

Please be informed about the exciting excursions that form an integral part of your courses at HAS green academy, the university of applied sciences. These excursions are designed to exchange with the international professional field, providing opportunities to connect with experts and expand your professional network.

As you may imagine, organising these excursions involves certain costs.

The estimated budget for 2024-25 is as follows:

- 3-day introduction/team building € 200.- (applies to IFA 1, and 4)
- Semester course excursions  $\in$  100.- (applies to IFA 1, 2, and 4)

The excursion and literature costs are published in the course information in 'Osiris'. This app is used by all HAS students, specifically for course outlines and exam results.

The applicable excursion downpayments which will be invoiced to you during your first few weeks of your exchange programme at HAS. The invoice will be sent to your future HAS e-mail account and will include clear instructions on how to make the downpayment. You will be required to complete the payment within two weeks of receiving the invoice.

Please note that participation in excursions is compulsory. If you miss an excursion, you will not receive a refund from your excursion budget – and you need to align beforehand with the course coordinator about an alternative assignment.

In addition mid-way the second semester in IFA 2 a weeklong international excursion will take place, for which an additional budget of  $\in$  550.- is estimated. The invoice for this excursion will be split into two parts, to be paid in February and March. Please align beforehand with the IFA study advisor till when and how you can register to join this international excursion.

For all excursions applies, that if the actual expenses are less than the estimated budget, the excess will be refunded to the participating students. These refunds will be processed within a reasonable timeframe after the conclusion of the excursion <u>year</u>, with the aim to finalise all matters by week 21 of semester 2 (i.e. mid July).
